



Getting Ready for Your New Door Installation

When we are scheduled to come to your house to install your new garage door, we will need you to make sure a couple things are done so we can put in your new door.

- Access to your garage. We'll need you to either be home or by pre-arrangement enable us to have access to the garage in your absence (eg. Side door left open, key code for your keyless entry).
- 2. Clear work area. We'll need clear floor space in the garage to lay out and assemble your new door. We'll need floor area at least as wide & high as the door. For example, if we're replacing your 16'w x 7'h door, we'd like to have clear floor space of 18'w and 10' deep.
- 3. Please remove vehicles out of the garage before we arrive.
- 4. Sideroom and headroom clearance. We'll need some room around the door tracks at the side of the door to remove and/or attach the track brackets 6"- 9" is enough. We'll also need room above the door to remove and/or attach the torsion spring assembly 12"-24" is enough. Please remove any shelves that might be encroaching on the clearances.
- 5. Remember that when we're putting in your new doors, your garage is a "constructions zone". There are potential hazards present. Please keep young children and pets away from the area when we're working.
- 6. If we are rehooking up to your existing opener/operator: We cannot guarantee the working condition of an existing garage door opener at the time of installation of a new garage door. Pre-existing wear or defects may arise causing failure which cannot be predicted or compensated for. The Garage Door Opener is a separate, independent system from the Garage door. New Openers installed by LOD/EGD carry a warranty on defects and workmanship from the date of install.
- 7. Our technician will collect the final payment upon completion
